The Hong Kong Association of the Order of Malta Limited (OMHK) will be hosting the 3rd Asia Pacific Order of Malta Youth Camp from October 23 – 26, 2019. Over 50 young people with disabilities and 100 volunteers will come together in Hong Kong for a once in a lifetime week of fun, friendship and adventure. Guests from all around the Asia Pacific region, including Australia, Philippines, Thailand, Hong Kong and Singapore will take part.

Historical Background

The Order of Malta, one of the oldest institutions in Western and Christian civilization, is devoted to in upholding human dignity and care for people in need through its medical, social and humanitarian works. Every year, the Order of Malta holds the International Summer Camp for Disabled Youth, in a different country – Italy, France, Belgium, Ukraine, Hungary, Spain, Germany and Lebanon, to mention a few. The first Order of Malta Summer Camp for Youth with disabilities was held in 1984. Our goals are the same now as they were then: to forge a sense of community, promote cultural exchange and help young people to overcome personal barriers.

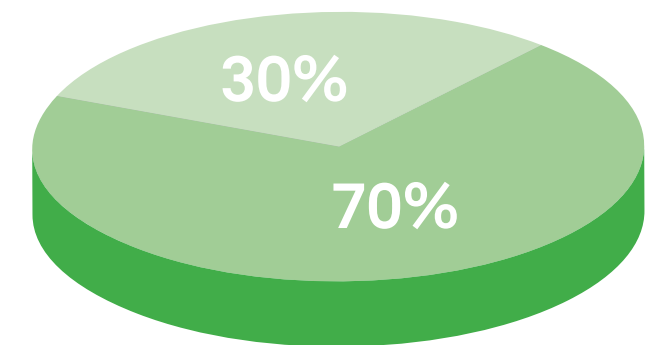
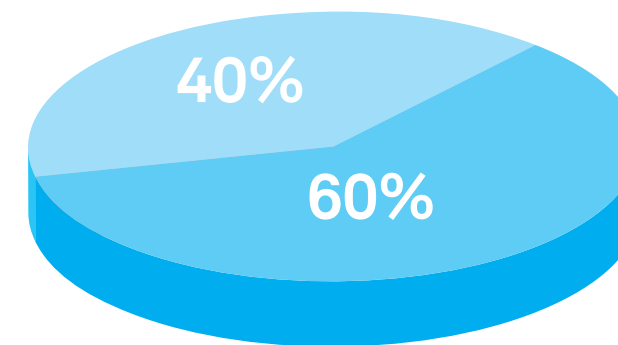
